ACTIVITIES TO INCLUDE FOR FUEL MITIGATION ON YOUR PROPERTY

YARD WORK

1. RAKING
2. LIMBING TREES UP
3. TRIMMING SHRUBS
4. WEEDEATING
5. BAGGING DEBRIS TO BE HAULED (HOW MANY BAGS)
6. TRUCK LOADS (HOW MANY LOADS TO THE DUMP OR COMMUNITY BURN PILE)
7. BURNING (MAKE SURE TO GET YOUR PERMIT ON LINE AT: <https://burnpermit.fire.ca.gov>)
8. BUCKING UP FELLED TREES INTO ROUNDS FOR SPLITTING INTO FIRE WOOD
9. SPLITTING ROUNDS INTO FIREWOOD

HOME HARDENING The cost of the following items can be counted.

1. EMBER RESISTANT VENTS (GOOGLE IT. There are many types.)
2. FIRE RESISTANT COVERING OF THE EVES OF THE ROOF (EXAMPLE: Fiber Cement Board, Metal, Stucco)
3. FIRE RESISTANT SKIRT SURROUNDING THE BOTTOM OF YOUR DECK
4. REPLACE PLANTS AT THE BASE OF THE HOME WITH GRAVEL, CEMENT, DIRT
5. FIRE RESISTANT VENT PIPE COVERS FOR THE ROOF
6. REPLACE ALL PLASTIC GUTTERING WITH ALUMINUM OR METAL
7. REPLACE WOOD SHINGLES WITH ASPHALT SHINGLES OR WITH METAL ROOFING
 - A. REPLACE ASPHALT SHINGLES WITH METAL ROOFING
