The teacher in Avo and Regina came out to organize the hunt for eggs for three different age groups.

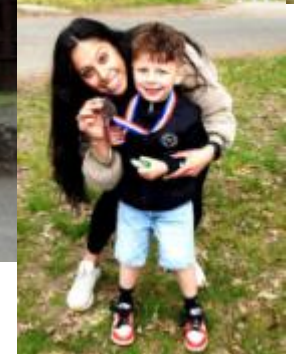
